THE OUTLAWS SURRENDER

Captured by Tooele County
Officers This Forenoon.

THEY HAD SLEPT TOO LONG.

Apprehension was in the Brush
in South Willow Canyon.

ARE OF THE WAY TO SALT LAKE.

Captain Talks to the Outlaws and
Representatives of the "News".
Extracted from Misses Helen
Sister Cross Report—Tended One
of Them—On—Coughlin Gave His
First and Said it Was the First
Time He Had the Opportunity of
Doing So Without Being Shot.

The Outlaws have surrendered.

They were captured by Tooele county
Court Infants in Willow Canyon the
victims. Coughlin was the first to
be captured. He said it was the
time that he had the opportunity
of doing so without running
risk of being shot down like a dog.
It was an hour later when George
arrived to follow the example of his
companion and the dog was very re-
spondingly taken. The dependents are
now en route to Salt Lake in
charge of the officers of the law and
will be here on the Utah Northern
the evening. The details of the
capture are specially interesting and
will be a special news representa-
tive as follows:

GEOGRAPHVILLE, August 6, 1 p.m.—
Coughlin was captured, the notorious
young horse-thief, who was captured in
the state of New Mexico last week,
and a posse of deputy marshals
arrested yesterday morning only to re-
port that no trace of him had yet
been made.

The officers had spent all Saturday
and Sunday night in the brush after
the desperado, who is reported to
have been seen, and at daylight,
surrendered every man and woman in the
village, but to no avail, the dog had flown to more dangerous
shelters.

After the officers had returned, two young men from Taylors-
ville, Morris and Mantle, called
on Sheriff Hardy and reported that
they had but their horses stolen from
Morgan on Saturday night. They
said they rode into town Saturday
night and that when they came they
were missing. Thinking that they had
been taken by the desperado, Coughlin,
when asked how he felt and what he
thought of the outcome, replied that he was in good spirits
and that he was not fatigued
and felt tired.
