**An Important Case in the Alderman's Court.**

Yesterday the case of Salt Lake City vs. Pat Lannan was before Alderman Clinton. The charge preferred against the defendant was for selling fruit in a place not authorized by law, being in violation of the ordinance of the city for the regulation of meat markets.

Mr. Smith, counsel for the defense, after some preliminary remarks presented the following motion to dismiss the complaint.

"Territory of Utah,  
County of Salt Lake,  
Jesse J. Clinton, Alderman of the Corporation of Salt Lake City, and Esquire Justice of the Peace,  
vs.  
Pat Lannan,  
Defendant."

The above named defendant makes special appearance in this cause, and moves that the complaint in this action be dismissed, and, for grounds of demurrer, says—

First—That the ordinance of said corporation of Salt Lake City, upon which said complaint is founded, was created by the exercise of legislative power assumed by the common council of said corporation; that the right to legislate, exercised by said corporation in the premises, is unauthorized by law.

Second—That the judicial powers assumed in this case by Jesse J. Clinton, as Alderman of said corporation, are not authorized by Act of Congress, nor by any authority delegated by Congress through the "Organic Act" of the Territory of Utah.

Third—That to hear, try, and determine this case requires the exercise of judicial powers, that neither such power nor authority has been conferred upon said Jesse J. Clinton by Act of Congress, nor by any authority delegated by Congress.

Fourth—That the exercise of judicial functions by said Jesse J. Clinton, by virtue of the office of Alderman of said corporation, is without warrant of authority in the legislative powers delegated by Congress to the Governor and Legislature of the Territory of Utah.

Fifth—That the office of Esquire Justice of the Peace is unknown to the law.

Sixth—That said Jesse J. Clinton has no jurisdiction if the pretended offense charged in said complaint against this defendant. That the authority to hear, try, and determine the same has not been conferred upon him.

Wherefore, this defendant prays that the complaint herein be dismissed, and that he be discharged.

Judge Z. Snow, Prosecuting Attorney, said that the substance of the motion had been presented in Court before and had been very properly too, he thought, overruled, and he therefore thought it unnecessary to make any remarks on the subject then.

After some further remarks on the part of the defense, in which an attempt was made to show that the ordinance under which the charge was brought was in violation of public policy, and should consequently be annulled, Mr. Smith entered the following demurrer.

"Territory of Utah,  
County of Salt Lake,  
Jesse J. Clinton, Alderman of the Corporation of Salt Lake City, and Esquire Justice of the Peace,  
vs.  
Pat Lannan,  
Defendant."

Defendant in the above entitled cause, not waiving any objection to the jurisdiction of the Court, demurs to the complaint, and, for grounds of demurrer, says—

that the government has tolerated this same Mormon polygamy for more than twenty years, that one, or two, or three, or a dozen men and women are not alone concerned in this matter, but probably seventy thousand, including children; that the mothers must be pronounced adulterers, and the innocent children illegitimate? It is a question which Congress alone should have grappled with, guided by the truth that kindness, with firmness, accomplishes its work better than force, and maintaining the sacredness of the falsehoods that have been told about them, the Mormons are, in fact, aside from their foolish practice of polygamy, the best citizens to be found in all our broad domain.

**PERSECUTION STRENGTHENS THE PERSECUTED.**—The Sacramento Union, though unsparingly condemning the peculiar institution of Utah, is of the opinion that the present persecuting crusade will fail to extinguish "Mormonism." The following extracts will show—

"Every country and every age has had its troubles from religious fanaticism. The human soul is in nothing so conservative as religion; hence every new faith or system has had literally to fight its way to success. And none has succeeded, and more prolonged struggle of it than the precepts of Christianity, and particularly the Protestant branches of that faith. Who reads history in the spirit of philosophy, applies the lessons of history to the current affairs of mankind, must conclude that the very best way to help Mormonism is to treat its gross errors with a degree of harshness which the world may tolerate into persecution."

We must not overlook the stubborn fact that it is not merely Brigham Young and George Q. Cannon who are on trial for polygamy. It is in fact the whole Mormon community, numbering one hundred thousand souls.

This part of the situation hints to a wise Government the necessity of mingling policy with justice, and of treating the question rather as a political than a judicial one.

In the event of their having to quit Utah they would probably go to Mexico or British America. Either of those nations would welcome them, both as an acquisition in favor of material prosperity—for whatever else they are, they are industrious, frugal, ingenious and temperate—and as confirmed and always reliable enemies of the United States. It is better that we should not have such an enemy for a neighboring nation, so long as it is possible, to retain their friendship. It is to be hoped these trials may not result in giving us a civil war. We are Congress.

Government would be exercising good policy by assuming an attitude of leniency toward this fanatical people. Time has been wasted to cure the evils of their system better than force and harshness.
