

WARD FIGHT IN PORTO RICO

San Juan, Aug. 11.—The Herald has received from the United States Marine Corps, San Juan, P. R., the following report: "On the morning of August 10, 10 Americans were stationed at the lighthouse on the island of San Juan. At about 4 o'clock in the morning, 250 Spaniards landed and attacked the lighthouse. The Americans fought bravely, but the Spaniards were repulsed with a loss of 100 killed.
