Maxican Legislation.

CITY OF MEXICO, 20.—The law for the issue of fractional coins presented to Congress by the president of the republic was passed yesterday. The bill, after an interesting debate, authorized the issue of \$300,000 in copper cents to be legal tender in sums of 25 cents or less. It is believed that the amount in whatever quantity the Executive may deem necessary. All old copper and silver coins will be coined in the same manner, and new ones will be coined.

The bill also gives the choice of paying unpaid salaries.
