

## THE TRIP NORTH.

In our last issue, we briefly noticed the return of Presidents Young and Kimball and their friends to this city, from a trip to Bear Lake Valley; since that, we have been furnished with the reporter's notes of each day's travel.

The style of traveling, character of the roads, and the places of resting being more of personal and local than of any general interest, we pass over the diary and take up the departure from Franklin.

Thursday, 19th.—Rolled out of Franklin at 6 a.m. It rained till noon, and continued in broken showers throughout the day. We made the mouth of the Pioneer canyon, in Bear River Lake Valley, at 9 p.m., bated our animals a short time, and resumed our journey through mud and mire, and reached Paris, Richland county, at 3 a.m. of the 20th.

Friday, 20th.—The weather wet, cloudy and uncomfortable. Paris is situated at the mouth of North Twin creek, has thirty-four log houses; is laid out in a low place along the banks of North Twin creek, which runs through an extensive willow patch. The distance from Franklin to the mouth of Pioneer canyon, in Bear River Lake Valley, is 36 miles, and from that point to Paris, 12 miles. Twin creek is supplied by a large spring, and the amount of running water is only varied by the melting snows and heavy rains. It is a large canyon stream, and calculated to supply an extensive settlement. The soil is a fine rich loam, and well adapted to cereal crops, roots, etc. About one mile from this settlement there is a large patch of hay ground, extending 20 miles north and south, and 10 miles east and west. The climate is well adapted to hardy fruits of every kind. The hills are covered with fine grasses, and promises well for grazing. Fish abundant in the lake.

Saturday, 21st.—At half-past eight a.m. we rolled out of Paris, to visit the infant settlements southward. We passed New Haven, which has since been named St. Charles, and bated our animals at Fish Haven, about 13 miles from Paris. Fish Haven is situated upon the borders of Bear Lake where it washes a rather precipitous shore. This lake is large and deep, the water soft and limped. After resting a little over an hour we returned to Paris about sun set. During the day we passed over a splendid farming and grazing country; a great number of acres had been broke, and some wheat was up and looking well.

Sunday, 22d.—A public out-door meeting was held opposite the dwelling of Elder C. C. Rich, at which President Young delivered some very interesting remarks on the labors before the settlers, encouraging them to build so as to protect themselves against the attacks of the Indians, to be careful about going in to the canyons, to educate their children, to build good and comfortable homes, and to adopt laws for the punishment of the lawless. Elder Taylor also addressed the meeting.

During the progress of the President northward from this city, one hundred and thirteen persons joined the company to visit the new settlements; altogether, there were eighty-six persons in carriages and sixty-seven horsemen. On Monday morning, the company started homeward, reached Franklin the same evening, and continued in easy journeys till their arrival here as before reported. During the trip, Presidents Young, Kimball and the members of the Twelve addressed the citizens on their every day labors, on education, fidelity to themselves and their Creator, and as usual, the most cordial welcome was extended to all the visitors, and every thing was done to render their trip pleasant and agreeable.

Prussia—Count Bernstorff and Privy Councillor Balan, formerly ambassador at Copenhagen.

The German Confederation—M de Beust, Saxon Minister.

Russia—Baron Brunnow.

Sweden—General Wachtmeister.

Denmark—Baron de Bille, M. Quade (the Minister for Foreign Affairs,) and Councillor Krieger.

The Conference unanimously appointed Earl Russell its President, and the Hon. William Stuart as Secretary.
