What Will the President Do?

BUFFALO, April 25.—The Commercial

Advertiser to-day says: "An important

point bearing on the present discus-

sion as to whether President Cleveland

does or does not want to be re-nom-

inated is as follows: A prominent

democratic politician of Rochester,

who was once an intimate personal friend

of Cleveland, and knew him well when

he was in the White House, recently

visited Washington recently to

talk over the Rochester postoffice ap-

pointment with the President. This

gentleman was one of the most enthu-

siastic boomers for Cleveland in West-

ern New York during his campaign for

governor and president. Cleveland

received him most cordially, and spent

an hour with him in general conver-

sation. After the immediate business in

hand had been disposed of, they talked

over old times, and a variety of topics

came up. Finally the Rochesterian

rose to withdraw, and remarked to

the President:

"I have not been in Washington for

twenty years, and did not care to come

again," he added, "I would

come down to see you inaugurated for

the second time. The President

immediately replied with great emphasis

and apparent sincerity, "My dear Col-

umb, if you want to go, go."

The Rochesterian then

retired from public life. The visitor

has left the President's presence

fully impressed with Cleveland's

generosity and willingness in what he

said. The Rochesterian was reported to

be in Rochester one day last week.

By a dispatch to-day, it is

reported that Col. Dorchester

had sent the letter written by Presi-

dent Cleveland positively refusing to

be a candidate for a second term, Dor-

chester said to-day:

"I never saw the letter

mentioned."
