

DEEP CREEK MINERS.

They Will Help the Railroad that Builds West.

RIVER KILLED AT BINGHAM.

Local Association Officers—The Copper Home—Mining News from Various Sections.

The Deep Creek miners held another meeting last evening and discussed mining and railroad matters. Harvey Harry was chairman and G. A. Henry secretary of the meeting.

E. B. Coleman reported that he had received many names of Deep Creek miners who were willing to help him if they were willing to render all assistance they could to the enterprise.

Prof. Marion E. Jones said that he had visited twenty-three districts and examined the country anywhere in the Deep Creek country, and he thinks it is better country anywhere in the West. Fish Springs was a new camp two years ago. At that time the deepest hole in the camp was 100 feet. With the exception of this camp, which has six months produce fifty tons of ore each day, averaging 250 ounces in silver and from 40 to 50 per cent lead. Within a year it could double that amount. The miners are now working at the rate of 100 tons and the price of such ore, 25c per ton.

Assayer Hodges said that today there will be no more gold in the mine. The ore from that mine is the best during the winter. There will probably be some more gold in the summer, but there will be very little interest in it.

The speaker estimated that there is enough ore in sight in the Deep Creek country to amount to \$1,300,000 for the railroad investment. In one year the miners will have \$100,000 worth of ore, and with a return of \$1,000,000 a year will give a higher return than any other road in the country, and taking what is in sight the miners will be no doubt satisfied with what can be expected to make a handsome return on the money invested.

M. H. Evans, C. C. Gouwin, H. J. Frost, and others addressed the meeting. H. J. Frost and John Hartman were elected to the board of managers for a subscription committee for railroad stock. M. H. Evans, Art Young and Harvey Harry were appointed to act in conjunction with the railway committee of the Chamber of Commerce.

The following resolution was adopted, and the meeting adjourned to meet on May 10 at Epham, Deseret Creek:

Resolved, That we, the miners interested in the Deep Creek country, do hereby signify our hearty support to any railroad that may offer us so circumstances that a railroad will be extended into that country. That we will contribute to the amount of our ability in cash and property to any project looking to this end.

The body was held in the hospital until this morning by Dr. Bingham. Nathan was 19 years old and living in the Highland mine but a short time.
