The Boomers.

WASHINGTON, 13.—The Post to-morrow

will print an interview between

Capt. Couch, leader of the Oklahoma

"boomers," and the Secretary of the

Interior in regard to Oklahoma.

Lamar said: "What is it

you wish?"

"I want to know what course the

administration has determined to

pursue with reference to Oklahoma and

settlers," replied Capt. Couch.

"Well, sir, I will refer to you the

policy of this administration with

reference to this Oklahoma country,"

said the Secretary. "It considers the Okla-

homa territory, in which the persons

you represent are proposing to make

settlements, as within and part of In-

dian Territory. The Secretary

regards it as not a part of the public

domain open to entry and settlement

and the acquisition of title under

the laws of the United States, but

is, in the Indian Territory; that is,

its territory is reserved and reserved

for Indian occupancy. The Government

pledges to the protection of it and the

security of the Indians who reside

there and reside without a permit, and

to protect the territory from the

intrusion of white persons who claim

to have a right to enter upon it, and

that is public domain subject to pre-

emption and homestead settlement.

"Is that the final decision?" asked

Capt. Couch.

"It is, and it will be enforced!" re-

plied Mr. Lamar.

In reply to further questions, Secre-

tary Lamar said the Administration

was determined there shall be no ca-

tion on the subject of the land. It

will not be permitted to graze their cattle

within the limits of that Territory. He

repeated this declaration with em-

phasis.
