His sole object in coming to this country is to sign contracts for the construction of a railroad from Viotoris to Brownsville, Texas, a distance of 250 miles.

He has instructed Lennox to look out for iron-clad steamships for sale in this country, that can be used as war vessels in an attack on Miragone from the sea.
