Two Brothers Shot in an Arizona Saloon Brawl.

THE SEDGE DITCH LITIGATION.

Riding Appeal from Alaska-Red Cup Chambers-Vерdict Against a Railway.

H. H. Major, the recently appointed postmaster of Rawlins, Wyo., has been converted to \$500,000 in his post office.

Henry U. Tamm, the old man who shot and killed Deputy Sheriff Joe Howell, near the San Joaquin stage, Cal., on Thanksgiving night, had been captured six miles from Rawlins by Deputy Sheriff Wagner.

Away with strike was made Wednesday in the Five Quarter Club, Salt Lake City, about 100 saloons being closed, mostly in timber stocks and showing \$50,000 in sight. The show is half way.

Sheriff Rogers of Dodgeville county, Kas., arrived at Phoenix, Arizona, Wednesday morning, from Mexico, bringing with him G. G. Norman, arrested in Sonora. Norman exacted \$200 from the Mexican Telegraph company at Phoenix. He left the money in the bank holding 10 cents.

Five Chinese, at a Chinese gardener's house Little City, were held up by two masked men Tuesday night, about 9 o'clock. One of the robbers stood guard with a double-barreled shotgun, while the other fired the Chinese. The two were and held almost to what little money they had. Then the robbers backed off into the dark. The Chinese gave chase and several shots were exchanged, but the robbers made good their escape.

The California supreme court has sustained the verdict of an Alameda county jury awarding Mrs. Clara Howland \$10,000 damages in her action against the San Francisco telephone company, the Pacific Consolidated Street Railway company and the Consolidated Piedmont Cable company. Mrs. Howland sued both companies, but the verdict of the jury was against the Oakland telephone company, the company agreeing with H. A. Radford secured a verdict of \$4,000 a few days ago, for saving the life of his wife.

In the case of the Idaho Colonization & Irrigation company vs. Howard Seiber, in regard to the temporary injunction placed upon the sale of the Sedge ditch at Caldwell, Idaho, on Wednesday, intimated that counsel for defendant would have to make a very strong case to get the injunction dissolved, and that it in truth protected the interests of a large number of farmers under the ditch, it might even be the desire of the parties to the litigation. It is possible that the complications may be settled before the next term of court.

The Alaska Gold and Silver Mining company has brought an appeal to the United States circuit court of appeals to California, from the decision of a jury in the United States district court at Juneau. The suit is against that of the Alaska Gold and Silver Mining company against J. G. Brady, executor of the estate of T. C. D. ran, deceased. The controversy is over a mining claim known as the Canoe Lake claim on government land one mile from Juneau. D. ran owned the claim. The Alaska company took possession of it and Brady brought suit. He won and the company appealed.

Two brothers, two brothers, were killed at the Gold Cross mining camp, Cal., thirty miles west of Yuma. The tragedy occurred Saturday evening, and the brothers, it is understood, were engaged in a fight with a prospector named Jackson Bantophit. Mulcahy, a miner, and the Gonzales brothers were at the bar drinking when Bantophit walked into the saloon. Mulcahy, in an attempt to drive him out, shot him, thus shooting a man in the desert some time ago. He was held by Fanchon to stop the subject and not refer it again, whereupon Mulcahy became very abusive, and was struck in the face by Bantophit. The brothers then Gonzales walked out a shotgun and shot him twice at Bantophit without hitting him. The latter drew his pistol and shot Gonzales in the stomach. Juan Gonzales, who took the pistol from his injured brother's hand, leaped at it and Bantophit and the two brothers fought. The bullet hit Bantophit, who died twelve hours later.
