To Fold a Hymn-book.

The thickness of the book is an important matter. To make it the thickest that it is made so as to have twelve leaves-out on every thing to do off and on the reader will find if he tries.

The process is, nevertheless, simple but it has been hurried. First consider the width of the sheet lengthwise upon that; next fold the paper down its breadth in the center. Next fold the sheet across its length—thus fold the two leaves upon the front—only fold it again across, and you have your sheet in its distinctive form. Put your sheet in such shape that you may be served in with others from a book.—Exchange
