

NO PAYING THIS FALL.

The Time for Doing the Work This Year Has Gone By.

THE WEATHER WILL INTERFERE.

Agencies Proceedings Talked of by the Main Street Merchants.

Considerable speculation is being indulged in as to whether paying will proceed this fall or not. It is safe to say that no settlement will be made by the Chamber-Jennings or any other company in this city this year. It was stated in the city recorder's office this morning that work on the streets had been suspended for the year.

Mr. Collier, a member of the firm of the Chamber-Jennings, was called upon by a News reporter today. He said his company could not commence work on the streets until ordered to do so by the city engineer. The first thing necessary was to get the proper grade. After that carting and guttering would be pushed day and night. In the meantime, the city engineer would be in the city.

A recent meeting called for the working of three streets of the city last night. The company has already enough work on hand to carry out and gutter several streets and is getting it out at the rate of ten feet per day and will continue until the city engineer orders it to stop.

A strong possibility of delay lies in the contemplated litigation proceeding by the Main Street merchants, who positively declare that they will not allow the streets to be torn up until all suits are decided against them. They want paying but believe that it is not worth the cost. The city engineer will have to be out soon several feet between South Temple and First North streets before the permanent grade is reached. This will cause the city engineer to lower its grade. Before getting down to the permanent grade, the city engineer will have to get a new amount of dirt from the Lake and the other side of the same has not yet been filled, and it will cost much money to fill it.

All of these considerations point to inevitable delay. There are certain city contractors who are glad to be paid and would be pleased, however, to have the season for payment, to have the responsibility of the delay on the shoulders of the business men, the city engineer, the contractors, or all combined.

POLICE CASES.

PROVOC LETTER.

Trial of Jacob Davis for the Murder of His Wife—Subs.

Provo, Oct. 22.—Judge Blackburn last Saturday sentenced Jacob Davis to thirty days imprisonment in the Utah penitentiary on the charge of manslaughter. One of these elevating murder cases which horrifies the soul was commenced in the First District court on Saturday. Jacob Davis is charged with murdering his wife on the night of June 20, 1902, at their home in Tarry county. A jury has been empaneled, and Mr. Davis, assisted by prosecuting attorney, opened the case for the people. He stated that the prosecution expected to prove that on the night in question [Saturday] the Davis family retired as usual, the mother and her little girl sleeping in the bed, and Mr. Davis and several boys in another room. That in the morning Mrs. Davis was missing, and the defendant told the children that in one of her mad fits she had gone away; that she had taken one of the boys and had taken him away, and, according to her request, he had buried her like a dog, in a dump of refuse, because from the house, that the boys were not satisfied with the statement and went to Ashley and notified the sheriff, whereupon Davis became alarmed and made the statement that everything was all right, and that he would go right off and get Mrs. Davis, that while he was gone the boys commenced searching the premises, and in an old potato pit, the remains of Mrs. Davis were found; that subsequent investigations revealed that he had been struck on the head with a revolver, which he dropped nearby; that in the house were found blood-stained sheets, and under the bureau was found a dead cat, which had been used in wiping up the blood. Davis was captured near Fort DuCharme, W. H. Kling and Warner a coroner, later taken to Provo, where he was held for defendant. The plea of insanity will be offered.
