At Curtis, Nebraska, Wednesday afternoon a farmer named Gary shot and fatally wounded B. H. Hayes, editor of the Curtis Courier, in a quarrel over the ownership of some land.

Frank Thompson, the two-year-old son of Henry Thompson, a farmer near Oakland, Cal., Monday night, was fatally injured. The six-month-old child was playing on the street and did not hear the train approaching.

David Watson, aged 72 years, was struck by a trolley in Los Angeles, Cal., Monday night, and was fatally injured. The old man was crossing the street and did not hear the trolley approaching.

Charles McCallum, chief officer of the steamer Grey, while loading coal at the foot of Broadway street, San Francisco, Monday evening, fell from the deck and was killed. He was 46 years old and unmarried.

Leslie Nichols of Pacific Grove, Cal., brought to town a monster oyster shell that had been dug up by the southern part of the county Monday. The shell was about eighteen inches long and fourteen inches wide, and it weighed about twenty pounds.

James Ward, 51 years of age and a resident of California, was found dead in his car at the foot of Broadway street, San Francisco, Monday morning. He had died some time during the night, presumably from old age. The deceased was the proprietor of the mine now owned by the La Grange company.

Two young men, Frank Sherman and Harry Dixon, were drowned at Astoria, Ore., Monday morning. They were both students at the University of Oregon, and were on a boat when it capsized.
