A Half-Breed Indian Suspect
Lynch'd in Washington.

OUR ACCIDENTAL DROWNS.

Killed by a Train—In a Quarrel
A Building's Roofs—Imprisoned
Dysentery.

At Curtis, Montana, Wednesday
afternoon a farmer named Harry and
his wife were killed by a bear, which
had been captured in a trap set by
the owner of some land.

Frank Thompson, the ten-year-old
son of James Thompson, a former
trading post boy, Curtis, Mont., was
drowned in a creek near his home.

David Walker, aged 73 years, was
killed by a broad gauge locomotive at
Oakland, Cal., Monday night, and was
buried there. The man had been
crossing the street and did not hear
the train approaching.

Charles McCallum, chief officer of
the "City of Oregon," while boarding
that vessel at the foot of Broadway
street, San Francisco, Monday evening,
fell from the gang plank and was
drowned. He was 40 years old and
unmarried.

Louis Nichols of Pacific Grove, Cal.,
brought in a monster oyster shell
that had been dug up in the southern
part of the state. The shell was
about eighteen inches long and
fourteen inches wide, and it weighed
about twenty pounds.

James West, 51 years of age and a
native of California, was found dead
in his cabin at Weaverville Monday
morning. He had died sometime during
the night, presumably from old age.
The deceased was the discoverer of the
mine now owned by the Orange
company.

Two young men, Frank Sherman
and Harry Dickey, were drowned at
Astoria station, a short distance from
Long Beach, Cal., Monday morning.
Sherman, who was nineteen, got
beyond his depth, and Dickey went to his
rescue when both were washed out
into the breakers. The boys were
carried out Eagle Rock valley, near
Pendleton.

Rudd, Wyoming, Saturday, 21 is
currently reported that Henry Hol-
gate has left the country. Three
weeks ago this morning he dis-
appeared after visiting the bull camp.
He drew \$1,000 from the First
National Bank of Cheyenne, and left
a horse from his partner, Meritt, stat-
ing that he was going over into the
territory to buy cattle. He had also
money for investment from Sheridan
placed contingently as high as \$25,000.

Nearly 1,000 excited people gathered
at the residence of George Thackery,
and dealer, at the corner of Park and
Twelfth streets, Saturday night. The
crowd was drawn by a rather
peculiar circumstance. John L.
Williams, was passing Thackery's
residence in company with his son,
when he was stopped by a dog
owned by him. It was started by
loud barks from the animal, and noticed
that it was standing with its
now apparently glued to the packets of
the coal dealer's son. It was then
pulled off. On the way, Williams
noticed that the muzzle of
his revolver was gripped in the teeth of
a large building which stood with its
foremost truss against the base of the
tower, apparently wanting nothing
but to pull it down in its destruction.

The howl of the bulldog
brought people from blocks around in
the scene. Williams tried to break
the bulldog's hold, but failed. Then
some unknown person, who
probably knew the animal, began striking
at the animal's head. Still he held on.
Thackery came to the scene, and,
picking up a stick, thrust it through the building's collar, breaking
the tail of the bulldog, and then
releasing his grip. Before this was
done someone made a shot at the bulldog
with a large knife, and stabs the
back of Thackery's hand, dis-
abled him. A policeman had
already taken the animal. A
policeman finally solved the problem
by lifting the bulldog into his custody
with his club. The animal retained
a large chunk of the bulldog's muscle
and skin, and was bleeding freely, but
his hand was clasped in every direction
and his left eye was missing.

Ingraham, in Boise, Idaho,
States from Spokane, Washington,
says that Tuscar, Miss Mary
Richardson, 18 years of age, started on
backpack for Lapwai, on the Nez
Perce reservation, alone. At a point
east of Spokane, she was captured
near White Fish, she was captured
by Frank Hill, a notorious Nez
Perce hardened desperado, who ap-
peared suddenly from the bushes,
grasped the horse's head, and
shouted and commanded the Indian
to stop. Hill then commanded the Indian
to escape by whipping the horse
until Hill's powerful grip on the
horse was never relaxed. After a fierce
struggle in which she leaped off the
horse and fell under the Indian's
feet, he continued to drag her to the
ground. Hill then beat her and
dragged the struggling woman to
the brush, a short distance, over-
turned her by crushing her almost
into the ground, and commanded her
to stop. After this, Hill, an Indian
from the same tribe, who had been
seen around Miss Richardson's last
resting place, just before she was
captured, came to the Indian
and said, "You are a bad Indian."
Hill then beat him, and the Indian
then turned and fled.
