(Special Correspondence.) PROVO, Aug. 9.—The prohibition campaign in the city election this fall promises to become interesting. Just what action will be taken by the two parties is not known, but it is probable that both parties will declare for pro-hibition or that the people will vote for and against prohibition, and in the event of the majority favoring prohibi-tion, of which there is no doubt, then whichever party wins will enact a prohibition ordinance. Just what the liquor interests and the anti-prohibi-tionists will do is not known, but they will not be idle. The saloon men of the county met last week in Pleasant Grove and organized for the campaign. They have employed counsel and will be prepared to take advantage of every chance for continuing their business. The prohibitionists have patitioned the county commissioners to cease issuing licenses after the first of the year. This they are willing to do but the decision rendered by Judge Howell in the case of D. A.
