

TELEGRAPHIC. AT THE SEAT OF WAR

The Turks Advancing Both in Thrace and Epirus.

HOPELESS CONFLICT FOR GREECE.

But the Hellens are Determined to Defend Their Country to the Hilt and.

LONDON, April 30.—Today's news from the seat of war indicates that the advance of the Turks in both Thrace and Epirus, and that the Greeks are actually conceding the time and place of the principal attack. Despite optimistic views held in certain quarters in Athens, the cabinet seems about to enter a hopeless struggle. A comparison between the armistice of the two armies during the Balkan campaign, however, reveals the strength of the Turkish force and the weakness of the Greeks. It is a fresh illustration of Count von Moltke's saying that no army goes upon its belly.

Naturally, Gen. Benakakis makes the most of his humiliating success at Vasilovo with a view of putting the courage into his army. He is, however, as the Greek commander, in order to defeat the Turks at Vasilovo and consequently demand the evacuation of the peninsula. He has been just arrived.

The news will publish tomorrow a dispatch from Vienna which says the powers do not approve of Turkey's continued preparations for war.

THE WAR NOT YET ENDED.

LONDON, April 30.—It is officially stated that there is reason to believe that European intervention between Turkey and Greece in the present position of affairs is regarded as wholly impracticable, both Greece and Turkey having received the same message. The powers are thus obliged to stand aside until one of the combatants is finally defeated.

THE TURKS' TERMS OF PEACE.

NEW YORK, May 1.—A special to the New York Tribune says the terms of peace Turkey has offered Greece have reached the Washington government. They are as follows: The restoration of the boundary fixed by the treaty of 1813, which gave to Turkey all of Thessaly, including the extensive coast; the evacuation of Greece of Greece and other points in the province of Epirus; the withdrawal of the Greek troops from Crete and the acceptance of the plan of autonomy offered the island by the P. and O. The payment of a war indemnity large enough to cover the expense of the mobilization of the Turkish troops.
