GREATER ACTIVITY IN NORTH TINTIC

Increasing Force at Eagle and Blue Bell—Grand Central and Victoria Shipping.

(Special to the "News.") Eureka, May 10.—There is a lot of activity in North Tintic at present. Among the properties that are working at this time might be mentioned the Selma, Tintic Humboldt and Tintic Silver. At the former a double compartment shaft is being put down under contract.

It is the intention of the Tintic Empire company to install an electric hoist as soon as the shaft has reached a depth where a winch cannot be used. The shaft has been sunk to a depth of 290 feet and there are now about 30 men at work in the mine, aside from leasers, and in addition to the ore the leasers are hauling out three carloads each month.

The Grand Central and Victoria mines were started up Tuesday and the output of the properties at this time is about one car-load daily, this being the amount that the Victoria smelter can handle to accept for the present.

SWANSEA EXTENSION STRONG. Finding of Ore Causes Heavy Selling.—Iron Blossom is Slumpish.

The report of finding ore in the Swansea Extension property in Tintic caused a heavy selling of the stock on the local board this morning. During the regular board 10,000 shares changed hands. The stock reached as high as 4 1/2 cents, then dropped a tick slightly. Persons acquainted with the property are confident that the same good ore will be found in the property.

Iron Blossom was uneasy again today and from \$2.05 the price was carried down to \$1.92 1/2 on the regular board. The market throughout the session was slow.
