## A SPRING IN A WATCH.

## AN IMPORTANT BIT OF STEEL THAT FREQUENTLY BREAKS.

Watchmakers say that sudden changes of weather are dangerous to these certain pieces of machinery—especially in exposure.

"Manufacturing up very much like pictures," said a Broadway watchmaker the other day. "They are as anxious to avoid damage as any man is to avoid being a human being. When the thermometer is hovering around the freezing point or dancing away in the sunshines the little machinery will give up in disgust and smash itself and me, just as men succumb to freezing or smothering."

This uncertain piece of mechanism is supposed to be adjusted to meet the various demands of weather, but when the change is very great and comes with short notice, there is nothing that can prevent them from snapping. They are made in Switzerland of the very finest quality of steel, absolutely flawless. Very often the watchmaker can detect a bad spring before putting it in the watch, either by the color of the frame or the spring. There have been cases where the watch has been repaired, and instead of being restored to quite a red heat the fire has been brought to white heat, thus weakening the strength of the metal.
