The workment employed in this foundry are nearly all Swedes who learned the business in their native country. There are about 35 of them employed in the works at the present time. A new system of manipulating wrought iron has just been introduced in the east the importance of which, if correctly reported, can scarcely be over estimated. The Boston Herald of the fifth isst, says: A large number of scientific men from all parts of New England and New York assembled at what has long been known as the Satellag foundry, at Neponset, yesterday, to witness the first casting of wrought iron scrap by the Mitis Wrought Iron and Steel Casting Company. The company is incorporated under the laws of Mass-achusetis, with a capital of \$125,000, and have purchased the Shelling pro-perty, consisting of a brick building and other buildings for offices and other purposes, and an acre of wharf room, tall of which originally cost \$15,000. The foundry has been fitted with large dry ovens for drying monids and three furnaces to be heated by crude petroleum, coal not being capa-ble of heating to a sufficient tempe-rature (4000 degrees to 5000 degrees) healthy Liver.
