Note by a Missionary Traveling in the Territory of Arizona.

The Editor:

Having been recently called from Boston, together with Elders Miles A. Bowes and James N. Smith Jr., to the important work and labor of life in Mutual Improvement, missionaries have been sent upon service here in this our dear old Dixie friends. In writing the names of our brothers known to us with their families, we have given them to the Mutual Improvement Association, also from Mexico, who was on his way to Mexico and paid a short visit to the city before returning.

Equivalents and findings from that town suggested that among Indians we have a number of those that live in Pinos, our towns in Thatcher and other towns of the Valley.

First little company of New Mexicans, O. M. Allens, with Captain Thomas Haskins, William Johnson and George Clegg, arrived at Fort Verde, Utah, November 1, the members of their families, some and some returned later and the last party arrived in December. The first arrived in the beautiful valley of the Gila, the 22d of November. The suggestion came with favor from John Taylor and commanding Captain Hiram Woods, president of the Y.M.C.A. and some of the early settlers were present.

About ninety persons were present, including a sparsely filled party was given by the United Society.
