Wanted His Letters.

A Fleet of Whalers for the Atlantic.
Alexander McDonald, the inventor of
the whaleback boats and builder of the
whaleback steamer, Charles W. Wetmore,
which reached Liverpool Tuesday
with a load of wheat from Duluth, was
at the Illustrated News yesterday. "On
Sunday," he said, "we sail for the
construction of steel plates, angle iron
and bolts will be completed at Duluth,
and we shall immediately lay the keels
for ten more whaleback boats for service
on the Atlantic."

We will build a whaleback steamer
400 feet long, with cargo accommoda-
tions for 2,000 passengers, for service
during the World's Fair. After the fair
is over it will be cut in two and taken
to the Atlantic. It is possible that we will
build more than one of these boats
as we have anticipated and will be
summoned into existence."

The steamer, Captain McDonald
will, will load with a partial cargo of
machinery for the new shipyard on
Lake Huron, near Sault Ste. Marie, and will
then proceed to the Great Lakes to take
material for the great iron boats to be
built on the Pacific coast. The Amer-
ican Steel Barge company, which is build-
ing the whalebacks, is largely composed
of officials of the Northern Pacific rail-
road.—Chicago Tribune.
