ANNUAL REPORT OF THE HORN SILVER

Expert Declares Mill Could Wring Million in Profits from the Low Grade.

WILL DECIDE ON TREATMENT.

Small Profit Made on Account of Metal Prices and Difficulties At Smelter.

The Horn Silver Mining company, which is one of the famous old producers of the San Francisco mining district, Beaver county, has just issued its annual report for 1908, which contains some interesting statistics relative to the treatment of the zinc ore that is found in large quantities at the mine.

It is declared that within a comparatively short time a final report will be made in the mill treatment of the zinc and black ores at the mine. He asserts that it is gratifying to the company that the low price of metals materially impaired the income of the company for the year 1908, and that in addition the company was thrown out of much time through delays in the starting of the zinc smelter and its numerous shut downs before it was placed in running order.

General Manager M. C. Morris in his report shows that during the year 1,390.96 tons of ore were extracted for shipment and that the estimated tonnage on hand, Jan. 1, 1909, in bins and broken down at the mine was 1,000 tons. The cost of extraction, 800 and 700 foot levels in a new territory.

MUCH DEAD WORK.

During the year the company did 1,477 1/2 feet of dead work consisting of upraises, drifts, winzes and air shaft retimbering. During the year the air shaft was retimbered from the surface to the 100 foot level, on the 500 level and extending down to the 600 level. Considerable lead silver ore has been developed that should produce a fair profit on the cost of extraction.

MAJESTIC IN BETTER ORE.

The Boston office of the Majestic Mines company is in receipt of a wire from Manager A. D. Moffat stating that the face of the north drift shows a full breast of ore assaying 55 ounces silver, 24 per cent lead and 24 per cent copper. The last assay received from the south drift a year ago showed but 36 ounces silver. The walls have not yet been encountered.
