To prevent the becalming of sailing vessels, a Scotch inventor has contrived an apparatus which is now being applied to a new ship at Dundee. It consists of a four-bladed screw, four feet in diameter, which, when the vessel is overtaken by a calm, is to be fixed to the rudder, and is propelled by a skillful adaptation of pulleys leading over the stern of the vessel to a steam winch which is used in the loading and discharging. The propeller can be shipped and unshipped with great ease. It is calculated that it will give the vessel a speed of two or three knots per hour.

The steamship *Europa*, of the Anchor Line, upon its last arrival at this port from Glasgow, brought out freight free, 10,000 Bibles for the freedmen, these being the first part of a donation from the United Presbyterian Missionary Society of Scotland. Another lot of Bibles will be sent over to this country in September. Of course the United States Government admitted them free of all charges. It seems a little queer that Europe should be sending Bibles to this country, when our own Bible House is sending ship loads of them to Asia, to help to line the tea-chests of the Chinese.—N. Y. Some years ago the Emperor of the French was astonished at the great space occupied by flour when packed in sacks in the usual manner, and imagined that it might be compressed into a much smaller bulk, and be thus rendered easier of transport.
