WASHINGTON, Feb. 4.—The movement of the government of the United States for the holding of a congress of representatives of all the republics of the Americas to define and endorse the Monroe doctrine, and to establish commercial and political relationships between them, is rapidly taking form. The American minister here, John C. Davis, has already discussed the project with the other members of the diplomatic body who come from the South and today, to give an official announcement of his mission, he addressed a circular signed by the ministers of foreign affairs of Ecuador, of the members of the nations of Central America and sent the circular to their respective foreign ministers. A copy was received also by Secretary of State, and it is expected that the circular will certainly be presented, as it was the Pan-American.
