## EVENING NEWS.

### Extraordinary Ocean Voyage.

From the Philadelphia Record we condense the following account of the remarkable experience of the steamer Mark Lane, of London, which arrived at Philadelphia, May 9, after a voyage of 49 days. Her commander, Mr. W. J. Wainwright, tells the story of the voyage.

We left Dundee, Scotland, with a cargo of 2,000 tons of potatoes and bags, March 21, with a strong wind blowing from the northwest. When abreast of Cape North the wind began to blow a gale, and continued so until the 31st, when the sea was running much higher. We were then about 900 miles from land. On April 1, I found that the coal, owing to the violence of the weather we had encountered, would not be sufficient to carry us to Philadelphia, so I determined to make St. John's Newfoundland, in order to coal up.

The ship's course was, therefore, changed, and we steamed in a northerly direction, then to the usual taken. In latitude 47.40 and longitude 48.50 we began to see immense quantities of ice. We proceeded slowly through it, and after about 24 hours we were in a narrow channel, the ice being so close that we could not pass.

I decided to steer south, seeing little hope of making St. John's. I therefore determined to make Cape Breton, Cape Breton, the next calling place. The icebergs that we saw were complete islands, some of them being 300 and 400 feet high, and as much as a quarter of a mile long.

Never saw so many before, there being 40 or 50 in sight at one time. After clearing these we saw little ice until we reached latitude 48.50, and longitude 65 west, when a few patches were sighted. This was on April 7, and we were about 70 miles from land. We steamed through all day, when the ship got up a lot of heavy ice, and we decided to stop until daylight. When day came we discovered that we were surrounded by field ice. The ice was not icebergs, but the ice that is brought down by the St. Lawrence River, and largely made up of snow. It was in immense cakes, some of them being 100 feet long, and 20 feet wide.

Some of the pieces we pushed aside weighed 8,000 to 10,000 tons. The ice extended in every direction as far as the eye could reach. The weather was very dark, and the wind was blowing from the north, and the ship was drifting in the ice.
