New York, 30.—The World's Washington special says: Schleicher, chairman of the sub-committee on foreign affairs, investigating the Texas border troubles, has been informed by the State department that Foster, the American minister to Washington, has been summoned to the State department to meet the committee. Relating to Houses of Ill-

SECTION 1.—Be it ordained by

the City Council of Salt Lake City,

That no house of ill-fame

shall be kept for the pur-

pose of prostitution or lewdness;
