IDEAL BROILING.

Broiling can be done in the oven of the Charter Oak Range or Stove with the Wire Grate and Meat Broiler, more perfectly than over the live coals.

Let the steak, chops, ham, etc., lie on a wire broiler or meat rack, placing it in an ordinary base pan to catch the dripping. Allow it to broil for ten minutes in the oven, with the door closed 15 or 20 minutes. No turning is required. At the end of this time it will be found nicely cooked ready to serve.

There is no taste of coal gas or smoke, and the meats are more tender and better in flavor than those broiled over the coals. The convenience of broiling in the oven will be appreciated by every housekeeper, and adds another to the many reasons why the Charter Oak Range or Stove should be preferred to all others now in the market.
