An Agreement to Have Longer Session in the Senate.

THE TWO REPEAL MEASURES.

Regarding the Appointment of an Ambassador to Italy.—The Plates.

The Course.

WASHINGTON, D. C., Sept. 22.—In the course of the repeal bill was taken up and George Davis, of Mississippi, excused his speech begun on Wednesday, against the bill.

Hastings (Dix) of North Dakota then addressed the Senate in opposition to repeal.
