



Washington, 18.—Consideration of the Utah bill was resumed. Hoar offered an amendment to strike out the clause abolishing woman suffrage in Utah. Rejected, 17 ayes, 31 noes. Those voting in the affirmative were Blair, Bowen, Brown, Culiom, Conger, Dawes, Dolph, George, Hoar, Lapham, Manderson, Mitchell, Palmer, Pike, Sherman, Vance and Wilson.

Brown explained his vote by saying he was parsonally altogether opposed to woman suffrage, but regarding it as an entirely local matter, and as it has been established in the Territory, he would vote against the United States interfering with it. The bill then bassed by 30 years, 15 nays, as follows:

Yeas—Allison, Beck, Bowen, Cameron of Wisconsin, Colquitt, Conger, Cullom, Dawes, Dolph, Edmunds, Fair, Frye, Gariand, Harrison, Ingalls, Jackson, Jones of Florids, Jenes of Novada, Lapham, McMillan, McPherson, Mahone, Manderson, Miller of Californis, Mitchell, Merrill, Palmer, Pike, Pugh, Rieddieberger, Sawyer, Voohses and Welch—33. Nays—Bayard, Brown, Coke, George, Hampton, Jones, Kenna, Lamar, Marcey, Morgan, Pendieton, Itansom, Vance, Vest and Walker—15. Adjourned.

The Utah bill as passed by the Senste provides that the lawful husband or wife may be compelled to testify in prosecutions for bigany, polygamy or inilawful cohabitation. In such prosecutions, an attachment for a witness may be issued with a previous subpeens, when it shall appear to the judge that the witness would unlawfully fail to obey the subpoena. Bali may be accepted for the appearance of such witness, and in any case he or she shall not be held longer than 16 days. Every marriage ceremony in any Territory of the United States shall be certified in writing, with the full names of all persons taking part in the ceremony, and shall be signed by them, and shall by the officer or priest solemnizing the marriage, be filed with and recorded in the Probate Court. Such certificate shall be evidence of the facts stated. Any violation of the provision is punished by a fine of not more than \$1,000, or imprisonme

Any violation of the provision is punished by a fine of not more than \$1,000, or imprisonment of not over two years, or by both. Every such certificate and record shall be at all reasonable times open to inspection to any justices of the United States, who are under the like penalty for refusal to exhibit for inspection. Women shall not be entitled to vote in Utah. All measures of the Territorial Legislature providing for numbering or identifying the votes of electors are disapproved and annulled, but this provision is not to preclude the lawful registration of voters or any other provisions for securing a fair election, that do not involve the disclosure of the person for whom the elector voted. Probate courts are deprived of all jurisdiction, except as to the estates of deceased persons and the guardianship of the person and property of infants and lunatics. All laws of the Territory of Utah conferring the rights of inheritance on illegitimate children are annulled. Territorial laws providing that prosecutions for adultery can only be commenced on complaint of the husband or wife, are annulled, and all such prosecutions may hereafter be instituted in the same such prosecutions may hereaf-ter be instituted in the same skinned husband and father gives the sub-

rations without the approval of Con-gress. In all proceedings for enforce-ment against corporations or associament against corporations or associations holding property in any Territory in excess of the amount limited by law, the courts shall have the power to summarily compel the production of all books and accounts belonging to any trustee or manager of the property in which such corporation may have any right, title or interest. All laws of Utah relating to the Perpetual Emigration Fund Company are annulled, and it is unlawful for the Legislature of the Territory to create or recognize any corpor-

lawful for the Legislature of the Territory to create or recognize any corporation or association having for its object the bringing of persons into the Territory for any purpose whatever. The Attorney General is directed to institute in the Supreme Court of the Territory proceedings to dilsolve the company named, and dispose of its property and its assets according to law. Such property and assets, in excess of the debts and lawful claims established by the court, shall excheat to the United States, and shall be used by the Secretary of the Interior, under the direction of the President, for the benefit of the common schools of the Territory. All existing election

abolished, and it is made the duty of the Governor, the Territorial Secretary and the United States Judge of the Territory to redistrict the Territory so as to secure an equal representation of the people. No persons but properly qualified citizens of the United States are entitled to vote in the Territory. The bill declares vacant the office of Territorial Superintendent of District Schools, and vests the power of appointment of such official to the Supreme Court. It provides the penalty for the crime of adultery to be imprisonment in the penitentiary not exceeding three years. The right of dower for widows is secured by provisions similar to the dower law of the State of New York. The bill now goes to the House.
