SOWING DISEASE.

THE spread of contagious diseases is often remarkable, and the means of their communication frequently beyond the ken of the closest observer. But there is a method of scattering the seeds of suffering and death which is very prevalent, and can be easily stopped. Furtherthose who continue it after being told of its consequences will deserve the severest punishment.

Children afflicted with whooping cough and other diseases highly contagious, are taken out for an airing, and the mothers, nurses, or persons in charge, make calls on families where the little ones are caressed and petted and kissed by other children, the disease is communicated by contact, or generally by inhaling the breath of the afflicted, and thus a previously healthy and happy home is frequently invaded by the destroyer, and sorrow and mourning take the place of gladness and peace.

It would seem that words of caution on this subject would be unnecessary to people with common reflection. But it is a fact that many individuals appear to act in these important matters as though ordinary sense and judgment had no place within their brains. All persons, young or old, afflicted with any contagious disease should be kept as far as possible from contact with the healthy, and the carelessness of those who, in the manner we have described, carry misery and death into the households of their friends, is little less than criminal and very nearly unpardonable.
