

Bare About Irrigation.

Overseas Thomas has reported the following letter:

Reno, Nev., Sept. 30, 1891.

Dear Arthur L. Thomas, Chairman of the Western Executive Committee, Salt Lake City, Utah.

Dear Sir—Your letter asking the calling of an irrigation convention in Nevada was duly received. I venture to assure you with a calm mind that no irrigation convention will be called by the present administration, calling an irrigation convention at Cheyenne on the 10th of October.

"I am glad that your are taking measures to have an irrigation convention held out of the Salt Lake convention. You ask me for my suggestions which referred to concluding the irrigation bill as follows:

"No calling suggestion is there. That

the proposed bill, I am sure, will be passed in the fall. Let us hope

that at every irrigation opportunity

will be improved by our committee with

the irrigation bills introduced in the

National conventions. These other bills

were introduced by the various state

legislatures last spring.

The several State and Territories repre-

sented in the Salt Lake convention

should be invited to their

conventions held next year. A thorou-

gh Western convention, including all the

States and Territories, should be held

in the fall of 1892.

"It seems to me it would be best for the

executive committee to call a national

convention, with a few delegations from

each state, and a committee with

representatives from each state, and

that a delegate should be addressed

as such for the purpose of those

conventions.

"The action of the executive committee

was well taken, and the organization

should be continued through our

conventions.

"It might be well to remind the

executive committee of the

various committees and delegations

to ask for answers, giving the view of

the writers relating to this matter.
