DEATH OF ELDER W. C. STAINES.

Elder William C. Staines, whose demise has been sorrowfully anticipated for several days past, breathed his last in this world at 8:30 on Wednesday evening.

William C. Staines was born at Higham Ferris, Northamptonshire, England, September 23rd, 1818. He heard the gospel preached on his 32nd birthday, and was baptized into the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints about a year later.

Elder Staines had the faculty of making friends wherever he went. To the railroad and steamship companies he was as well known as any public man in the land, and was esteemed by all with whom he had business relations, whether Jew or Gentile, saint or sinner.

The funeral services will be held in the Assembly Hall, on Friday, August 5th, at 3 o'clock p.m., to which the public are invited. He has gone to his rest after a life of more than ordinary usefulness, and at the age of nearly 63 years.
