DEATH AND RUINS.

Destruction Caused by Cyclones in Many Places.

PEOPLE REPORTED KILLED.

The Villages in Kansas Wiped Out of Existence—Much Property Damaged.

St. Louis, April 12.—Last night's storm did widespread damage in this city and vicinity. Houses demolished, a large amount of glass all over the city. In addition to the boats mentioned in last night's dispatch, a steam yacht belonging to an English lord was blown away, with half a dozen small boats. It is not known how many persons were aboard the vessel, but it is not believed that they met with any serious accident. From all over the city and suburbs, reports of houses, barns and other buildings blown down. No loss of life is reported so far.

All boats here from the mountains have been recovered. None was badly damaged.

MID AND MAIL.

Several others were injured. The storm uprooted trees and damaged other buildings. Houses were blown down. A number of cattle at various points.

SEVERAL PERSONS KILLED.
