## THE WONDERS OF THE WORLD.

This world is full of wonders, some known, and a great many more that are being discovered every day, and yet their number may be reckoned as legion. The telescope reveals untold wonders of the great universe in which our world is but as a grain of sand, when compared to others. The microscope in its turn, is one of the great agents which aids in discovering a host of wonders, in the insect world.

These statements are proved by the following facts, which have been discovered by various means:

It is said that the polypus receives new life from the knife that is lifted to destroy it. The fly-spider is known to lay an egg as large as itself. The caterpillar is said to have four thousand and forty-one muscles in its little body. In the eye of a drone, fourteen thousand mirrors have been discovered; and the respiration of a carp is produced by no less than thirteen thousand three hundred and thirty-three veins, etc. The thread of a spider is formed of four thousand other threads, which come out of as many minute holes in its body. Spiders, no bigger than a grain of sand, have been discovered with the microscope, which spin threads so fine that it takes four thousand of them to equal in size a single hair. Ants are known to travel in swarms several miles in length, and of great width, over large tracts of land, and their path is marked by barren tracks which they have stripped of all vegetable life during their journey.—*Printers' Ink*

**LIVE DUST.**—Mr. Dancer, a Fellow of the Royal Society, has been making a microscopical examination of the dust of English cities, and reveals some interesting facts about the same. City dust is generally regarded as a nuisance, from the irritation which it produces on the lungs, and the impossibility of keeping it off from the person or out of the houses. But according to Mr. D. there is another circumstance which will increase the aversion in which it is already held. In every specimen examined by him, animal life was abundant, the "molecular activity" varying according to the height at which the dust is collected. And of all heights which the animalcules could select for the display of their activity, the height of five feet is that which has been found to be the favorite.

Just at the average height of the foot-passenger's mouth, these floating, moving organisms are always waiting to be devoured and make us ill. Furthermore, as if animal abomination were not enough, a large proportion of vegetable matter also disports itself in the light dust of our streets. And the observations show that in thoroughfares where there are many animals engaged in the traffic, the larger part of the vegetable matter thus floating about "consists of what has passed through the stomachs of animals," or has suffered decomposition in some way or other. This unpleasant matter, like the "molecular activity," floats about at a height of five feet, or thereabouts.—*Boston Journal.*

**A NEW RELIGIOUS SECT.**—The existence of a new religious sect has been discovered in Russia, called the Skopzen, or Skopzi. The sect has been known to be in existence in Russia for many years, but has hitherto escaped the vigilance of the police. The Skopzen have most barbarous practices. The doctrine from which the name is derived is the mortification of the flesh, which they interpret as self-mutilation. The members marry young. After the birth of the first child, the parents are rendered incapable of further offspring. The object of this appears to be in order to keep the family wealth undivided. The treasury was discovered in the house of a rich merchant in Morskens. His name is Maxim Plotzky. His house is so large as to occupy almost a whole quarter of the city, and served the purpose of a kind of Skopzen nunnery. Nine nuns were arrested there at the time, and among them a sister of the sect. Pictures and other property of the sect, were found in one of the rooms. The treasury was not discovered without great trouble. The large cellars were searched in vain. At last, after passing through six vaults, on entering the seventh, suspicion was excited by a large stove, which stood in one corner, and which appeared never to have been fitted up for use. On examining it an iron door was discovered behind it, leading to a secret apartment, which contained immense wealth. Besides an enormous box full of gold imperials, there were also found about fifteen millions of silver roubles, and above ten millions in bank notes. This was the chief depository of the sect, and had been collecting for the past century. The sect is supposed not only to be a religious but a political association, and it is said that this immense wealth was intended by the Skopzen to found a new Russian empire.

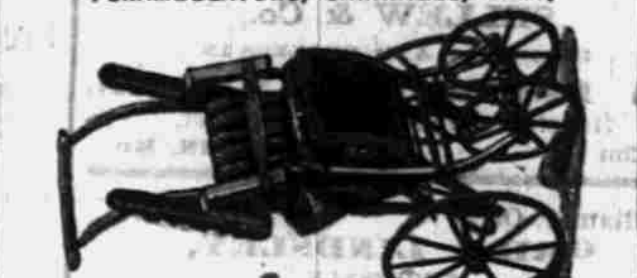
