

Germany's New Literary Methods

ONE of the most satisfactory symptoms in the German publishing world is the tendency to forsake the methods of Prof. Dryasdust, and to write even historical records in a manner that makes them good reading as often as good works of reference. If it is argued that this is not a tendency but a happy

survival of the great age of German literature, I would reply by inquiring if any reader can find in anything half so interesting as, for example, Mommsen's chapter on Sulla. Some years ago a thrill of horror would have passed up one's spine at the suggestion that one should look up "something about ancient Egypt" in a German textbook. Conceive the appalling

completeness of such a work, the wickeder the didacticism, the more coarse the words, and the brain-forging excursions on ancient Egyptian social measurements! Perhaps I am prejudiced, but at least that sin is committed in good company. And anyhow the complaint would now be unjustified, a most Hellenic Schiller has written a most interesting account of his native monograph on the subject in the series "Development of Mankind," published by Vogtlander in Leipzig.

Monumental it doubtless is not, but it is worth reading for its own sake,

and of how many monographs is that true? You come across a chapter on Egyptian poetry and romance and seated leaves them in pictures and yet parts of eastern entertainment as "The Sailor's Adventure" and "The History of the Peasant Who Could Speak." It may be a strong picture of a native gulfing his nose over the "Egyptian schoolboy set to row on this probably." A man has seven cats. Each cat eats seven mice. Each mouse has seven grains, and each grain produces a sevenfold crop. Count the total number of cats, mice, ears of corn, grains, and harvest! Then you

are told that the Egyptian schoolboy was taught to reckon in the scale of seven.

And I know of a German Cleropriest which begins with the most human document Cicero ever wrote: that postscript to a letter—"Give my little pupil a little kid." There is nothing new in that, but it is sometimes supplemented. The collection of modern colored school books from the baby-primer upwards is a fresh sign of the tendency to introduce young readers to subjects by exciting their interest—"literary humanists" in a new sense.—London Tribune.
