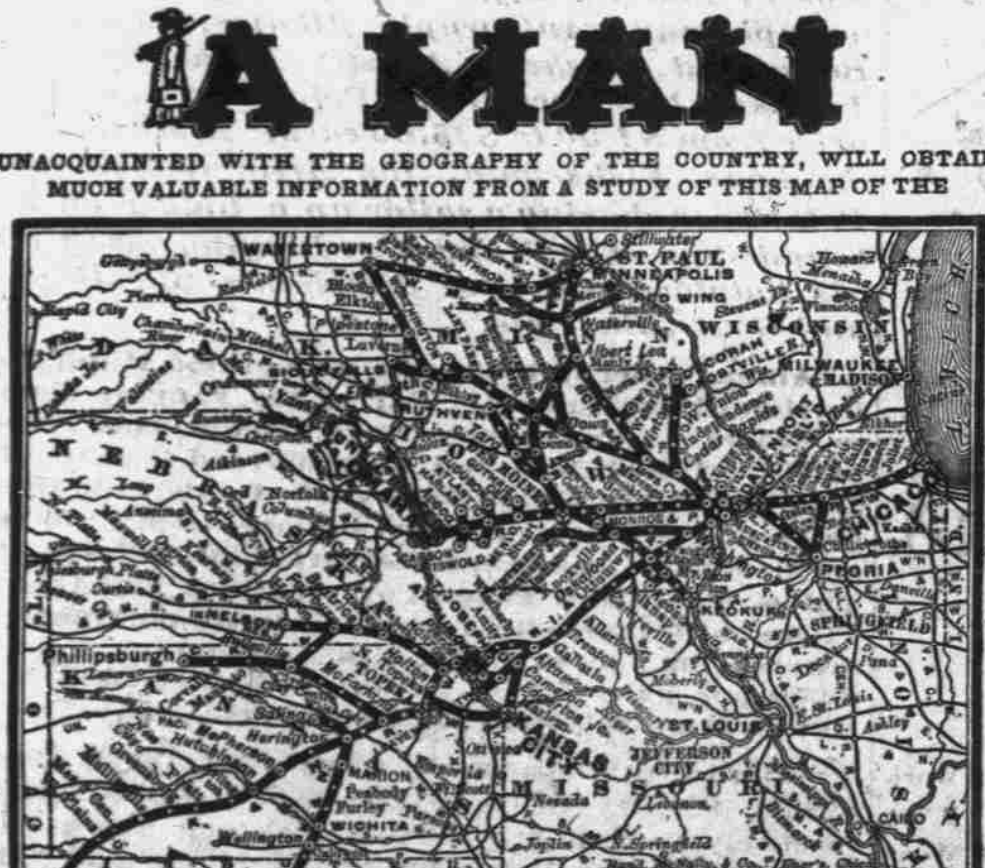

**Criminal Cases.**  
Chicago, Dec. 17.—George Webber, ex-superintendent of the north division branch postoffice was arrested last night charged with embezzling money from the postoffice.  
Stanley H. King, ex-money order clerk, was also arrested. The amount of embezzlement is said to be large.

**S. P. Bonds Gone—Other Deaths.**  
TROY, N. Y., Dec. 17.—John Howson, the well-known comedian, late of Boston, died here today.  
OMAHA, Dec. 17.—Hon. S. P. Bonds, editor and principal proprietor of the Omaha Republican, died at 8:00 o'clock this evening of pneumonia, after an illness of ten days.  
He was a resident of Omaha a little over a year. He came here from Washington, D. C., after the death of his wife, a public printer, which he held for four years. For many years previous to coming to Washington he was proprietor of a printers' supply house in Chicago. Mr. Bonds was well known and popular in the country, and particularly in the west.

**WASHINGTON.**

The Inter-State Commerce Commission.—A. H. Hines to the Irish.  
WASHINGTON, Dec. 17.—Secretary Fairchild has decided to appoint Perry C. Smith of New Jersey as chief of the appointment division of the Treasury Department, in place of Mr. Higgins, resigned. Mr. Smith as a cousin of the secretary, and holds the position of disbursing clerk of the Postoffice Department and was personally complimented for his business capacity by the Postmaster-General in his last annual report. He will relieve Mr. Higgins in January.

THE HEARING  
of the case of John H. Martin and H. J. Martin, of Denver, against the U. P. R. Co., alleging violation of the long and short haul clause of the interstate law, was continued before the Interstate Commerce Commission today.

Thomas H. Kimball, general freight agent of the Union Pacific road, and W. G. Clements were called as witnesses in the hearing. The Interstate Commerce Commission today heard testimony from Mr. Kimball and Mr. Clements regarding the long and short haul clause of the interstate law, which was continued before the Interstate Commerce Commission today.

Defendants claim that under the circumstances stated above, there has been no violation of the interstate law, and that the Interstate Commerce Commission should dismiss the complaint.

ACTING SECRETARY MULDROW  
In response to a letter from the commission of Indian Affairs, he decided that under the provision of the allotment act, the land is to be held in trust for the Indians, and that the allotment act does not apply to the land of the Indians.

ASST. SECY. MAYNARD  
has written a letter to the collector of customs at New York in regard to the question whether the schedule tariff might safely be prescribed for all goods imported in hogheads, tierces, casks, and barrels, which are not in the different lots of the same kind of packages the department concurs with the collector at New York in the opinion that a uniform rate of duty on hogheads, tierces, or bags, containing goods, is not only impracticable but could result in disadvantage of the government for the reason that the importer would have the right to claim actual tare.

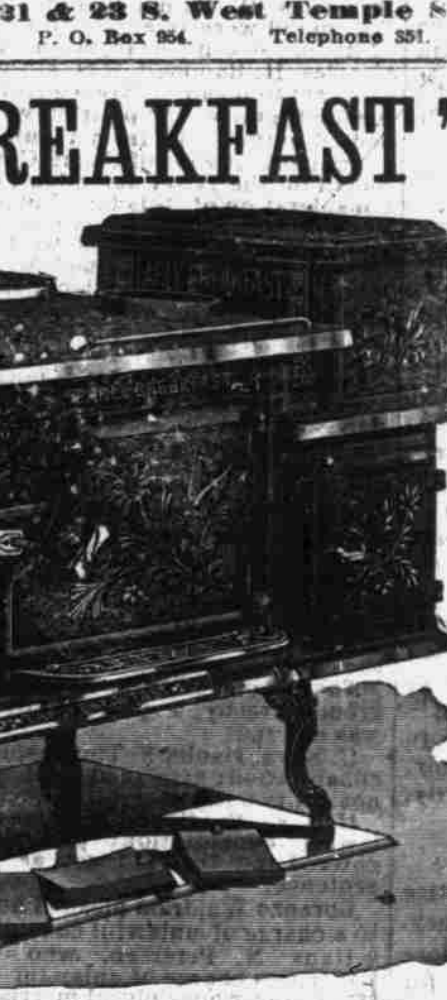
