

ELDER HAAG'S DEATH

In Far of Turkey and what Brother
Don C. W. Miser Wrote
Regarding It.

The News is kindly permitted to publish the following letter from Don C. W. Miser, sent to the First Presidency of the Church, regarding the death of his fellow missionary, Elder Adolf Haag:

MORNING CANADIAN HOSPITAL,
Near Haifa, Turkey, Oct. 18, 1882.

Referring to the demise of my beloved brother and fellow worker in the cause of truth, Adolf Haag. I will say he died of typhus fever, which had been five minutes past four. On the 10th of October, the day after I addressed you my last letter, Brother Haag was taken ill and notwithstanding everything that human means could suggest, he did nothing being done, he gradually sank lower and lower until the angel of rest was sent to loose the hands holding him to this earth of sorrow and pain, and bid him rest "and息ed on high and perfect" for the last time. At this time he was taken sick until his spirit was waked above, and said unto them "I have come to do no service, but to give it; not even when he got it as was I not given it to feed him and lift him from poverty to the other, did I realize I would soon have to part with my energies and noble soul, and die even more affliction than this pain, and finally in death, after our long walk to the cemetery listening to the funeral music of the village bell made to toll as much respect for the man of God, who had labored so faithfully and self-sacrificingly, before his earthly tabernacle was consumed. The services were so lovingly prepared to strew an aisle grave, it is hard for me to realize how little time there was. Brother Haag died here but a short time, had made a host of friends, as witness by the large concourse of people, all anxious to show their sympathies by coming to the funeral, among whom I saw the German Consul, Mr. H. W. Schmid, who have been very kind to us. The mayor of Haifa, who entertained us all one afternoon listening to our testimonies, and in fact nearly every one in the colony was in attendance.

Testing Diamonds in India.

The Indians distinguish diamonds according to their color. The white rank first and are called Benamis, the yellow are known as Valdys and the brown stones as Marwars—these three are the chief Marwars—a rare white are the chief stones and money-holders in India. These tests are performed by means of the phosphorescent and electric qualities of the diamond and they are also tests of the extreme uniformity of its specific gravity.

A healing solution of some sort of resin, called by the natives "Tinmangam baa," which solution has a specific gravity of 2.2, is used for the weight test. Into this solution the stones submitted for examination are thrown.

That those are rejected as bad as the Marwars, the Marwars knowing that the diamond has a specific gravity of 3.2.

The stones that are then examined are the larger pieces are raised with a silk handkerchief to exert their electric properties and held near light instances, as small pieces of these pieces diamonds thus raised readily attract light instances. The phosphorescent qualities are brought out by exposure of the stones to sunlight, and then taking them into a dark room, where the diamonds are seen to glow.

One stone which has been tested as diamonds are then examined by boys especially trained, who put them according to their color and flaws, and it is very seldom that these youngsters make mistakes, so sharp are their eyes in detecting flaws and shades of color.

A simple property of water, many simple experiments show that the surface of water possesses a property which causes it to repel the passage of bodies either from above or below. This is true, not only of simple water, but of the upper surfaces of leaves dry. This is due to a great number of minute hairs covering the face of the leaves. Water cannot penetrate into these hairs even when the leaves are forced down beneath the surface.

The little tufts of hair that protrude above the water are kept from sinking and from being washed through this same principle. The tiny hairs have their points all upward, and they are glued together so closely that while there is open space around the point of each hair, yet the width of these spaces is so slight that water cannot

enter and wash away the tufts.
