WASHINGTON.-The secretary of the interior, in his letter to the gov-Indian chiefs, now confined in the Texas penitentiary, explains, in addition to the recently published statement on the subject, that the first request, dated March 22nd, was revoked on the 14th of April in consequence of the excited condition of public sentiment at the time, growing out of the Modoc difficulty, and because of some objection to the pardon of Satanta and Bigtree by Gen. Sherman. Secretary Delano goes on to say, "I cannot omit to add that, in my lease under existing circumstances, will endanger our present peace-Comanches, and will be likely to result in hostilities with these and other tribes residing in Indian territory. I have therefore, respectfully to renew my request for sincere hope that your judgment will approve the same."
