Prospectors Return from the Henry Mountains.

BAD PLACE THERE FOR MINERS.
Land Patents.—To Advertise Utah
Notes of Mining and Real
Estate.

George Hinch and Paul Redenbacher have returned from the Henry Mountains, for which place they left Salt Lake on the 2d of January last, on a prospecting tour. Mr. Hinch has been in the abstract business in Salt Lake, but for a number of years has given his attention to mining. Mr. Redenbacher is an experienced miner from Colorado. Their recent trip has given them an experience which enables them to speak by the task on the Henry Mountains as a mining proposition, and will carry more weight than the "boom" literature issued regarding that district.

"We had a pretty hard trip," said Mr. Hinch today. "We intended, when we left here, to go to the San Juan country as far as the Henrys, but we met a good many easier back from the former place and decided not to go there. We went to the Henrys by the Hall's Crossing road, and left our wagon at Bluffing, on the west side of the park mountains in the Henry range. That was 50 miles away from any prospects. We had a good prospecting outfit, so from the point where we left the team we provided with our pack animals.

"There were no roads there, and the country is all broken up. I never saw such a rough place. Along the lower part of the mountains there is a good deal of washouts that seems turned up on edge and packed up through the sandy soil. Up in the mountains the formation is solid purple granite, with a good deal of shale. I don't know what the country is like, but I suppose it should develop quite a mineral vein."

"We were at Eagle City, though we didn't know it had such a name. There were no signs of civilization, except a mail train from Green River, and the stage only came in once up to the time we left. The store-keeper, McInnes, occasionally brings the mail down from Hanksville, twenty-eight miles distant. The stage comes in, but there isn't much patronage, as nobody is going into the mountains now. The mail to Hanksville comes by way of Dallas.

"We have been here as many people in the Henrys as have been arrested, but most of those there were experienced prospectors. The highest number at any one time was possibly a little over a hundred. Many of the prospectors from Colorado, who were drawn to the Henrys, by the talk of that place, and came through to Bluff City. Then they turned into the Henry Mountains.

"As to finding anything in the Henry Mountains, there has been nothing discovered up to the present outside of a few prospects in the Bremo basin. There is a streak here and there, but nothing worth working. In the Bremo basin all the gold is taken up. The miners are a fair-sized prospect, and owners are trying to sell, but have not done so when we left. The miners who were talking of buying had been given an extension of time. There are only two or three men working in the Henrys. There is no gold there, on Crescent Creek. Wilson's miners are about eight miles below, but mostly know where the gold is that comes from it. It should be out of the mountains somewhere. It is hard to find, though. We worked there and passed out several times, but found no pay dirt.

"We were in the Henry mountains four months, and went over them pretty well. We dug down to bedrock, but did not find anything worth having. Others did the same. There has been a good deal of prospecting outside of the Bremo basin, and by experienced men, but all were satisfied that they could not find gold. They did not dig very deep, but went down enough to learn that if there are any ledges they are blind ledges. If anything is found it will be by digging. There are no crags, the miners who went to them are encouraged. The person who goes in to get out the gold is a man who goes in to have enough with him to get out again. Everything is high priced in the Henrys, but on the road the prices are reasonable. There is no work in there now. There are only a few in camp."

"We never saw a man who made anything. The country is a poor one, and many have starved there. Cost of living is getting to be high from time to time, and it is difficult to support that amount, especially when we come out. There is good water in the Henry mountains, there being four or five good sized streams, and some small ones. We tried to get some water to drink, but could not find any water for mining purposes, if the mineral was found. Some pieces have been picked up, and from the copper state they were thought to be good. What answer can be made to that? There is no mineral here, but some of the prospects in the Henrys, nothing having been found yet. Over in the Bremo basin, which can be seen from the Henrys, there are some good size prospects, and when the owner is ready to sell the copper ore will come this way."
