WASHINGTON, July 25.—"The price, 250 1/2, an unbroken record, while unprecendented, perhaps, in the history of the market, is the result of the passage of the silver bill. You will observe, if you have watched the market, that silver is doing some very lively upward sprinting in the United States just at present, although yesterday it dropped a point. Certain persons in New York have for some time been engaged in getting a corner on the silver bill. The New York City Western National Bank has done some very clever work in this regard, and has succeeded in getting a corner on the silver bill. It is estimated that 2,000,000 ounces are in the hands of others in this city. The law goes into effect September 1st, and it will be impossible to sell anything like the quantity of silver that is now in the hands of the market. It may have a higher tendency, inasmuch as we are not prepared to buy 2,000,000 ounces a month, and it may be several points lower than it is today. But whatever is the market price, it is bound to pay. We have only today received the silver bill officially from Congress. Its provisions are engaged to be printed and published."
