

**ATTEMPTED MURDER.**

**Bloody Work of a Robber and Would-be Assassin.**

**A WOMAN SHOT AND BEATEN.**

The Alleged Perpetrator of the Crime in Jail—He Denies His Innocence—Is He the Man?

One of the most brutal and cowardly crimes ever committed in this city was perpetrated at the home of Mr. Phillip Adams, the well-known colored undertaker, near the corner of Eighth and Street, on the main branch, shortly after 8 o'clock on Saturday night. As a result Mrs. Adams is in a critical condition, suffering severely from a pistol shot in the abdomen and numerous cuts and bruises, inflicted by a murderous-looking colored, who fled with a year's savings of his victim.

Mr. Adams' undertaker shop is near the corner of Granite and Main streets on First North street. About a quarter past eight he caused his lights for the day and, accompanied by his nephew, Henry Hall, proceeded homeward. The two men reached their destination about twenty minutes after leaving Main street. The house is an old adobe shack with abandoned appearance and is somewhat isolated. It had been the custom of Mrs. Adams to keep a light burning in the window for her husband when he was not home at night. On this occasion it was not there and Adams wondered what it meant. On entering the house he found it dark. The door was slightly ajar and found everything in a disordered condition. Articles of furniture were overturned; trunks were opened and their contents strewn about the floor which were scattered about the room. A small amount of money had been laid out and was collected, about \$100, was far in excess of the expense of the district.

**Returned Home.**

Elder David Shuler, of beautiful Davis county, arrived in this city on the 21st, returning from a mission to the Northern States, for which he had been left on May 14, 1872. He had many opportunities, he says, of hearing his testimony to various classes of people, although the general sentiment seems to be indifference towards the cause of Jesus Christ. The pastor of the local congregation was present for the last month but was released on account of failing health. Otherwise he has enjoyed his labors.

The Union Pacific passenger train in this city at 4:15 p.m. from town south on Saturday night came near being wrecked. The engine, tender and car left the track over a split railroad near the Hanover station. The passengers were considerably shaken up and frightened, but no one was hurt. A passing train went down from the city and brought the passengers up.

**Obituary.**

P. C. Gossman writes from Hinsdale, Weber county, under date October 18th, as follows:

A promising young man, David Adams, born April 4th, 1865, in Salt Lake City, departed this life October 1st, 1895, in Hinsdale, where he had been raised from early childhood, beloved and respected by all who knew him. He had been a student at the University of Utah, at first in the theological seminary, but had been admitted to the law school and graduated in 1893. A few months before Mr. Keyes had gone to the police station and excitedly related a story about a robbery and the attempted murder of Mrs. Adams. In a short time he was arrested with a corporal and Dr. McAninch was on the spot, arriving soon after Mr. Adams.

Mr. Adams' injuries were found to consist of a long snake-like cut across the right side of his forehead and a bullet hole in the abdomen. After naturalists were applied she rallied sufficiently to relate the following story: About 8 o'clock, she said, a white man, whom she had slightly acquainted, called at the house and inquired if Mr. Adams was at home. On being given a negative reply he said that he would come to and wait for his return. Mrs. Adams invited him to sit down, but he sat in a chair, but before she had time to perform the courtesy the villain drew a checked pistol containing a load of lead from his pocket and struck her a terrible blow on the head. She fell to the floor, unconscious, and was again struck another violent blow, the force being so strong as to cause the metal to break through the muscle and break through the bone. Mrs. Adams declared as soon as she saw him that he has her poison. This Sawyer denied the charge, but was compelled to prove a complete alibi. Chief Paul says that Sawyer's reputation is good and that he has lived quietly and peacefully in the neighborhood for some months, making a living as a nation peddler. He was arrested at 12th and Main. He was taken to the police station where he registered as an ex-Confederate soldier, a native of Alabama and fifty-two years of age. His name was the order made by Chief Paul: "Take no bond whatever."
