CORNELL WINS.

The Leander Crew Re-
fuses to Start.

THE SPECTATORS EXCITED.

General Interest Takes in the Bu-
sy Regatta.

FIVE THOUSAND AMERICANS

Present to Witness the Race for the
Challenge Cup—Fine Weather
—Grand Scenes.

HARVEY-ON-THE-THAMES, July 9.—Cornell covered the course in 8 min. 17 sec.

The first heat for the grand challenge today at noon, the Trinity Rowing club, Cambridge, beat the London Rowing club eight easily, four lengths, in 7 min. 30 sec. High wind prevented action. Trinity Hall had the Banks or most favorable shore of the course.

In the first heat for the Thames challenge cup, the St. John's college (Oxford) boat beat the eight of the Thames rowing club by a length and a half, in 7 min. 57 sec. In the second heat for the grand challenge cup, the Eton college crew beat the eight of the Thames rowing club.

In the first heat for the Visitors' challenge cup, the Trinity Hall (Cambridge) crew beat the four of Cambridge.

In the second heat for the Thames challenge cup, the crew of the Nervous club, Amsterdam university, beat the crew of the Lady Margaret (St. John's college, Cambridge) boat club. The Dutchmen simply walked away from the Lady Margaret crew, and were not seen again.

Cornell and Leander were to start promptly at 3 o'clock. The wind com-
menced to blow from the south, so Cornell crew which has the Banks side of the river, Leander refused to start without word was given and the Corn-
ell crew rowed over the course. The
time of the race was 8 min. 11 sec.

THE GREAT EVENT.

HARVEY-ON-THE-THAMES, July 9.—The fifty-third anniversary of the "what looks like" grand challenge cup, considered to be one of the most interesting on record. This is mainly due to the fact that the seven entries for the Grand Challenge Cup, the "Race-Rimous" of aquatics, includes that from Cornell University, N. Y.

The Grand Challenge cup was first contested in 1852. The Leander rowing club, composed mainly of ex-Oxford and Cambridge rowers are the holders of this trophy, and the Leander crew will defend the record for the next 50 minutes if Leander, made in 1852, over the Henley course, and one-half mile.

Consequently there was an increase of interest in this event when it was known that drawing lots at the town hall of Henley would decide who would be to meet the Leander crew, the most prominent crewmen of Great Britain, this afternoon, in the first heat in which the Americans would part.

For the race for the Grand Challenge cup was rowed in seven minutes 22 seconds, and as the men from Cornell have frequently covered the course in a little over seven minutes, their admires, in spite of the many reports from training quarters, believe that the winning crew would have to beat the record.

A PICTURESQUE SCENE.

It has been pronounced impossible to imagine a more picturesque scene than that of a glorious day on the river and banks of the "Regatta Father Thames," between the Regatta Island, the starting point, and Henley Bridge, a short distance above the island. Henley is situated thirty-six miles from London, on the railway line running from London, through the Vale of White Horse, to the West Country district, and on regatta days crowds of excursionists travel to the great metropolis to the Thames near Henley to witness this unique and colorful carnival. The competing crews, the spectators, the boatmen, the boatmen, not their hundreds of horses, male and female, are the people who make up the picturesque scenes at Henley.

At a rough estimate fully 120,000 people will be present at the regatta when it opens Saturday evening, and ends on Thursday.
