Alcohol is not used, but for medicinal and general merchandise, which are imported chiefly from America, France and New Zealand, but the natives consume only such articles as they need for their daily life, and produce everything necessary to sustain life, including breadfruit, bananas, rice, plantains, sugar, and other articles. French and Cuban money is used. Taxes and customs house duties are paid in French money, but Cuban money is used almost exclusively. The value of the United States dollar is worth less than half a United States dollar; it is taken at par value with two English shillings and two and a half pence.

There are ten cents, twenty cents, fifty cents and one dollar pieces—no silver. The animal kingdom is not
