It would be difficult to do this, of course, in that case the suggestion contained in the item which we to-day copy from the *Provo Farmer* might be applied upon the using of a sponge attached to a long stick. Whatever the plan adopted, let the watchword be "War upon the caterpillars," and if we act upon it with energy and perseverance we may yet hope to rid our orchards of the pest.

Destroying Tent Caterpillars.—A Massachusetts correspondent of the *New England Homestead* gives this way of wiping out tent caterpillars, which he has practiced over 40 years. Probably the addition of a little kerosene to the soap suds would increase the effectiveness of the liquid: "Make a solution of soft soap and water, as strong as will be taken up by a sponge. Affix a strong piece of sponge (not too large) to the end of a pole, saturate it with the suds and pass it through the tent, wetting its inmates thoroughly, and the work is done and the tent benefited. See that the enemy is in his tent, which will be at early morning, at noon and late in the afternoon; at the other parts of the day they are usually feeding, and consequently not at home. An active man will, in a short time, destroy in this manner these pests of the orchard, over a large area."—*The Prairie Farmer*.

Work on the Temple.—Extensive changes are being made with a view to renewing the work of rock-laying upon the walls of the Temple in this city. The walls having reached the bare and the old scaffolding and hoisting apparatus having been removed, new derricks are being erected on the towers of the building and arrangements are being made for extending the guy ropes a greater distance. For the purpose of supporting the guy ropes which extend eastward two poles, each ninety feet in height have just been erected in the street near the east gate of the Temple Block, and the huge wire ropes will doubtless soon be in position.

TERRITORIAL ITEMS.

CULLED FROM LATEST EXCHANGES.

The grain crop of Idaho has already suffered much for the want of water. In the higher parts, half a crop will be realized.

Butte is infested with some desperate characters, who have garrotted and "stood up" some of the peaceable inhabitants for the insignificant sum of twenty-five cents.

A young German named Gottfried Stalberg put up at a hotel in Omaha last Thursday night. Being unaccustomed to the use of razors, he was instructed how to turn it off before he went to bed. For some reason he did not follow the instructions, but simply blew out the light and retired. Not making his appearance in the morning, his room was broken open, and he was found lying on the bed wholly unconscious. A medical examination showed that he was asphyxiated beyond hope of recovery and he died a few hours later.

Near midnight of the 28th ult., a citizen of Butte named John Johnson was assaulted by highwaymen, who slashed him severely, one blow cutting his lower lip completely in two. They stole his watch and chain and all his available cash, which, however, amounted to only \$1.20. The carter made good their escape and the victim was placed under the care of a physician who sewed up his lip and dressed his other wounds.

Mollie Lacy, a woman of loose morals, committed suicide at Boise City, last Monday. She had been ill and despondent several days previous to the deed, and while her attendant was temporarily absent from the room she procured a revolver of heavy caliber and shot herself in the head, tearing away a large piece of the skull and scattering her brains over the walls and floor. Notwithstanding the terrible character of the wound, she survived it one hour and a half. Word was immediately telegraphed to her husband and parents, who are wealthy and respected citizens of Council Bluffs.

The bodies of two men named Brazil and Flynn were recently found dead near Lewiston, Idaho, and their killing is involved in mystery. Brazil was shot in two places, through the heart and shoulder, and Flynn was shot squarely through the forehead. The two bodies were twenty feet apart and about 100 feet from their cabin. One pistol was found near the bodies, with only one empty chamber. An inspection of the cabin showed the table laid for dinner. Everything was cooked and a pan of bread was on the floor. Both men have been near neighbors for ten years and were well known as peaceable citizens.

A few days ago the dead body of a man was found near the foot of Kocks on the Jefferson River, Montana. He had evidently been murdered as he was shot in the right breast and his skull near the temple was broken in. He was a young man of medium size, had auburn hair and wore a substantial canvas suit. Appearances indicated that he had been killed several weeks, and perhaps months previous, as his body may have lain there frozen all winter. There was nothing about him from which his name or identity could be ascertained.

On the evening of May 1, as two men were employed in the Tye mine near Butte, a large rock loosened and fell a distance of about fifteen feet, striking one of them named Jones McDonald, and crushing one of his legs so badly that the bones protruded from his body. He was taken to the hospital in Butte, where his injuries, which, though serious, are not necessarily fatal, were properly treated. He will doubtless lose his leg.

Returned Home.—Elder Robert Braby of the First Ward, who returned from a mission to England last Tuesday, called this morning and gave us an interesting report of his labors in that country. He left here April 10th, 1895, and arrived at Brighton, his native place, twenty days later. Here he visited with his relatives for about two weeks, and had a pleasant time. He thought he failed to get interested in the gospel.

He was first appointed to labor in Sussex district and often had the pleasure of addressing the people on the level at Brighton, where his father had frequently preached many years ago.

During his absence Brother Braby labored three months in Sussex, three months in Berkshire, six months in Kent, four months in the North London Conference, and the remainder of the time in the Waithe Chapel Branch. He has had for traveling companions Elders C. C. Harris, Charles Denney, George J. Dent and C. E. Angell.

When laboring in Kent he baptized a captain of the Salvation Army and blessed a great number of children, many of whose parents were not members of the Church. He did not meet with the success, however, which he desired, and at one time became very much discouraged with the result of his labors and thought he could do no more good at home. While so despondent, one night dreamed that he had returned home, and in meeting his friends, they invariably asked him why he had come back so soon. Being unable to give them a satisfactory reply he soon began to feel much distressed, and to wish that he had remained in his field of labor. On awaking he felt thankful indeed that it was only a dream, but he concluded his labors much more cheerfully during the rest of his mission.

He was released and left for home on the 10th ult., exactly two years from the time of his departure from this city. While away he added quite a number to the Church, and gained a valuable experience which he appreciates very much; and he regards his two years' absence as the happiest period of his life.
