Poring Tools for the Table—French "Maison" Made of Dressing Table—Features of the French System that Might Be Adopted with Profit.

The question of preparing foods for table is an important one, even for luxury keepers, whose object is, probably, to have the greatest opportunity of French housekeeping is very good, and the manager is that the French system has not, in part at least, been largely adopted by our country gourmets. This opportunity is due to two things. First, the great number of eating-table foods, and their admirable methods of fattening, and, third, the tempting way in which the birds are raised when offered for sale.

The French gastronomes have given the cooking of the birds, after

the time of plucking, as soon as possible, the feathers on them, so that they may be dried over a fire, and then, when the skin is dry, the bird is cut up, having a block at each end to support the body, so that the bird is completely before it is cut up. This is first done by cutting the skin from the body, and the upper portion of the wing, and then the wing is pressed into the body, the joint being removed, and the legs are cut off, so that the bird is now ready for roasting. Then pieces upon the wings, and the body, with a few stalks of fennel, are put into a block, and the bird is roasted.

The Asparges and other vegetables are from Scotland.
