The Greek army has been increased to 11 battalions.

Russia approves of arbitration of the Greek question.

The Porte has finally ordered the release of the Prince of Meridites.

The famous Tontine Coffee House, New York, has been sold for \$138,000.

The ice in the river at Memphis is increasing and navigation is about closed.

A fire at Waterford, Conn., caused a loss of \$35,000; partially insured.

Secretary Sherman expects to visit General Garfield at Mentor on Saturday next.

A fire, this morning, at Bartlett, Tenn., destroyed several stores. Loss, \$20,000.

By a railway collision near Chateau Thierry, France, two persons were killed and 13 injured.

A republican caucus at Indianapolis last night unanimously nominated Gen. Harrison U. S. Senator.

The original Uncle Tom, made famous by Harriet Beecher Stowe's novel, is now lecturing in Chicago.

The Marquis of Hartington made a powerful speech, and Healy a violent one in the House of Commons on Tuesday night.

A London financial firm is considering a scheme for building a railway from Pesh, through Belgrade to Constantinople.

At the St. Peters' Insane Asylum on Sunday, one female inmate murdered another female, choking and beating her to death.

Representatives of the powers have been instructed to take collective action to induce Greece to accept arbitration.

The Irish members began obstructive objections in the House of Commons to-day, and the wrangle lasted some hours.

The engine of a steam thresher machine exploded this morning, at Lucan, Ont., killing one and injuring a number of others.

It is easy to see that Logan's ill-advised bill has not advanced the movement to put Grant on the retired list. It has few friends.

The Portsmouth, England, authorities have received anonymous warnings of a proposed Fenian attack on the government establishment.

Both Nevada houses took a vote for senator to-day, with the following result: Senate—Wren, 14; Fair, 10; Daggett, 1. Assembly—Fair, 41; Wren, 7.

The President of Orange Free State says his republic wishes peace for the whole of South Africa, and he hopes further bloodshed will be prevented.

John Sherman was nominated for United States Senator by the republican caucus at Columbus, O., on Tuesday night by acclamation and with three cheers.

The contested case of Haralson against Shelly, Fourth Alabama district, was dismissed on Tuesday by the House committee on elections, and Shelly's title confirmed.

Lieut. Schwatka has written a letter expressing his views concerning the necessity of sending immediate relief to the Jeannette exploring party.

It is officially denied that Gen. Skobeloff was compelled to fall back after his first engagement with the Tekke Turcomans, near Geok Teppe, on the 24th of Dec.

A finance committee for the World's Fair was appointed, and ex-Mayor Cooper tendered his resignation. Cornelius Vanderbilt was elected to fill the vacancy.

The Property Defense Association of Dublin held a meeting last night and adopted a resolution urging persons of all creeds and politics to join it for mutual protection.

The Boston wool market continues quiet.

The English authorities sent a detective on Monday to Bradlaugh to inform him that they were in possession of sworn information that there was a plot to assassinate him.

A Harlem freight car and a Third Avenue passenger car came in collision on the Bowery, N. Y., to-day. The car was wrecked and all the passengers more or less injured.

The new English ballot act, if passed by the present Parliament, will throw the cost of elections on the electors, instead of on the candidates, as has been the custom heretofore.

Logan is convinced that the Senate military committee intends embarrassing the consideration of his bill retiring Grant and he will prepare another and ask its reference to a committee less hostile.

General Garfield addressed a delegation of colored men last night, urging them to educate their children and avoid raising a color line, and not separate themselves as a class from the mass of citizens.

Shaw, on behalf of a large number of English, Irish and Scotch members, has asked Gladstone to receive a deputation of the Home Rule and Liberal members on the question of land reform.

A bill was introduced in the Senate on Tuesday to reduce the price of even numbered sections of public lands within the limits of any railroad, military or wagon road grants, to pre-emption settlers, to \$1.75 per acre.

The Secretary of War says several railroads are running through the New Mexican Reservation without permission, but suggests that the right of way be granted in view of the important character of the roads.

By the explosion of 100 pounds of powder, the store and grocery stock of J. P. Andrews & Co., at Climax, Kalamazoo County, Michigan, were blown to pieces on Monday evening; twelve persons were injured, several of whom will die.

James Ridpath lectured last night at the Cooper Institute, N. Y., before a large audience on what he knows about Boycotting. He said Victoria was an infamous woman and ought to be branded as such all over the globe.

The World's Fair Commissioners to-day adopted the Ilmwood site way north of New York, above Harlem, as the place for the fair. The public have no very great faith or confidence in the management who are not representative men.

The Bombay Gazette reports that a conspiracy was formed among the Hindoos and Mussulmans of Kolapore to massacre the Europeans at church on Nov 9th, to slay the native officers and get the soldiers to join them, 3,000 natives were in the plot.

At an annual meeting of the stockholders of the College of Music, Cincinnati, there was no movement looking toward dissatisfaction with the management, as had been rumored. The contract with Mapleson for the opening festival in February was approved.

It is learned that Jas. N. Ray, a notorious counterfeiter, once district attorney in Tennessee, who is half brother of Congressman House, was killed Saturday. The cause is not known except that he quarreled and had his head split open with an axe.

Speaking of Ben Holladay's claim, a correspondent says: This claim seems to create unaccountable excitement and interest in the Senate. No one has yet shown whether the Senate should order the payment of the claim without reference to the Court of Claims.

If it is said by those who are taking some interest in the movements of Blaine, that his resignation, if offered at all, will be offered within three or four weeks, in order that the vacancy may be filled by the Maine legislature and not by the appointing power of the Governor.

There seems to be little doubt, notwithstanding Jay Gould's positive denial of Monday last, that not only are negotiations for the consolidation of the Western Union and American Union Telegraph Companies in progress, but that the terms are practically agreed upon.

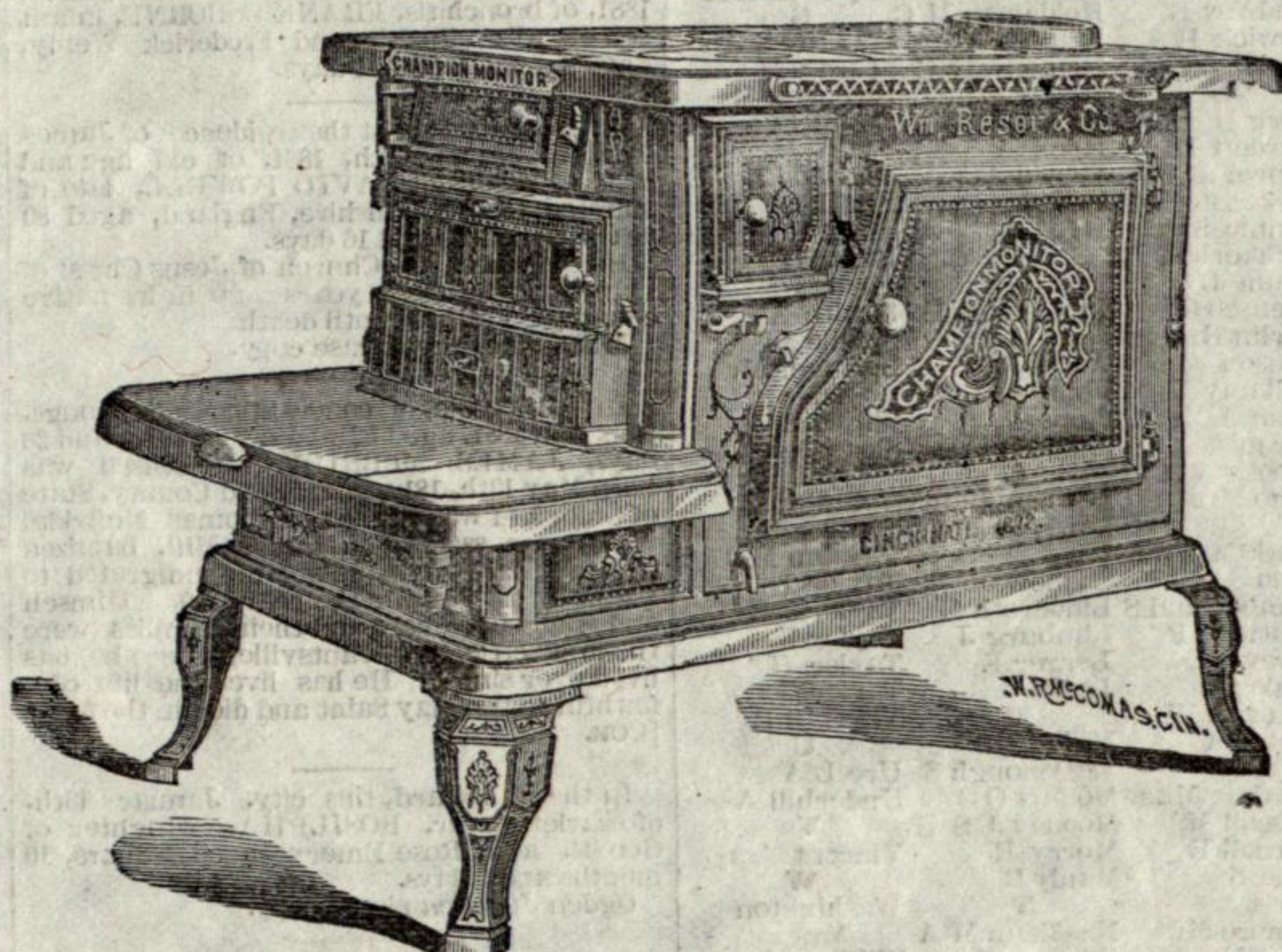
