Washington, 30.—The annual report of First Assistant Postmaster General Hutton gives the number of post offices in operation, June 30, at 48,231; increase, 1,719 during the year.

Eighteen hundred and fifty-one of these offices are known as "Presidential offices"; the remainder, 47,380, are filled by appointment of the Postmaster General.

The free delivery system is in operation during the year in 122 principal cities; 3,115 carriers were employed.

Total appropriation for this service, \$2,225,000, an increase of \$125,000 over the previous year. Total cost of service, \$2,233,162, leaving unexpended a balance of \$7,838.

General Hutton recommends that the delivery system be extended to towns within a short distance of one another, which have not already their required qualifications. Returns from all parts of the Union show very gratifying general increase of business.

The sum necessary to pay the increased salaries of postmasters, including 325 special adjustments, amounts to \$5,834,001 or 18.44 per cent. more than last year.

WASHINGTON, 30.—Judge Advocate Swain, in reply to the inquiry of the Secretary of War, takes the ground that officers of the army who refuse to pay their debts are liable to the processes of common law the same as civilians, and that where their acts tend to bring discredit on the army or in any way impair the efficiency of the service, they constitute sufficient cause for court-martial.

The United States Supreme Court today advanced the case of a coupon case, involving the State debt question, and ordered it argued January 9th.
