MAY 3.

1817—"First restoration;" Louis XVIII, brother of Louis XVI, made solemn entry into Paris.
1846—Thomas Hood, English poet, author of the "Song of the Shirt," died; born 1798.
1912—Eruption of Mont Pelee, island of Martinique.
1906—Michael Davitt, noted Irish patriot, died in Dublin; born 1846.

1782—John James Audubon, famous naturalist, born; died 1851.
1796—William Hickling Prescott, historian, born; died 1859.
1798—Outbreak of the last extensive Irish rebellion; it cost 20,000 English and 150,000 Irish lives.
1861—President Lincoln called for 42,000 volunteers for three years and informed foreign powers of his intention to maintain the Union by force of arms.
1906—W. P. Owen, noted American actor, died in New York city; born 1844.
