

LOCAL AND OTHER MATTERS.

THEATRICAL.—In "The Life of an Actor," to be presented to-night, there are a variety of good characters, which will admit of the ladies and gentlemen in the cast treating the audience to some excellent acting. LOSS BY FIRE.—We learn from a gentleman who was present that on Thursday last about noon, a stack of hay in Bishop Edward Hunter's stckyard, at American Fork, was set on fire by a boy shooting a gun near it. The hay was dry, and the fire ran along it in a few moments; and the other stacks close by were set on fire from it. The quantity of hay in the three stacks was estimated at from 75 to 80 tons, which was totally destroyed, with considerable corn that had not been husked. Through the great exertions of Bishop Harrington and the brethren there, the dwelling-houses and sheds, with a little barley, oats and corn, were saved. The loss is from a thousand to twelve hundred dollars to Bishop Hunter, and about three hundred dollars to the tenant.

The folly of permitting boys to have and handle fire-arms is very apparent when such things as this occur; and would be all the time if proper refection was bestowed upon the matter. The man or boy who would shoot off a gun close to a quantity of dry hay, possesses no more sense, or if any, but little more, than to fire it as close to a powder magazine; and as far as possible fire-arms should be kept out of such hands. In another part of this column may be found the name of another lamentable accident which occurred through the handling of a pistol by a boy, who was sent to be trusted with it. Such examples are, unfortunately, too numerous.
