

## WITH HOME ARTISTS

The Opening of Their Exhibition This Evening.

## FINE PAINTING OF MRS. WELLS.

Brief Reference to a Few Other Excellent Paintings—Splendid Water Color Work, and Etching Games.

The art exhibition has now opened and the artist who calls himself an artist or part of the opportunity of a visit to this temporary department of mind and brush genius will find the hour thereby. The formal opening occurred at six o'clock this morning and the exhibition will continue through the Holiday season. By that time it is fully hoped that every picture and sketch will be disposed of.

As the visitor inspects the exhibition hall, which will be the Theatre on the west, he is instantly surprised—absorbed at the scene of beauty that presents itself. In the southern corner—where he will sit all probability, by reason of the unusual arrangement, begin his scrutiny, his attention will be attracted to a painting by Fairbanks, called "A Gray November Morning." It is not such a morning as the artist loves to portray—the scenes of unceasing and approaching winter, and in this case the production is of such a character, that touches even the soul.

Next hangs a series of American Park scenes, painted by Edwin Evans, president of the Art Association of Utah. These subjects receive the artist's true treatment characteristic of outdoor work and will command the attention and respect of exhibition visitors.

On the same wall is one of Ward's H. C. Smith's very beautiful "Wasatch Range" sketches from the mouth of Red Butte canyon. The beautiful summits of the sturdy mountain range which borders the Salt Lake valley are shown in the light of day, with the clouds and the sky.

The cause of death was attributed to heart failure, or rheumatism, which had been increasing rapidly late. Thursday, apparently in the heat of health, and died suddenly at 5 o'clock this morning.
